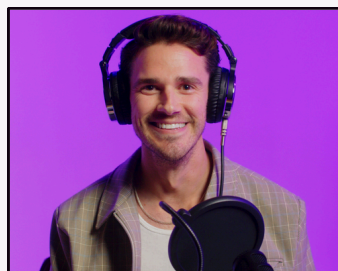
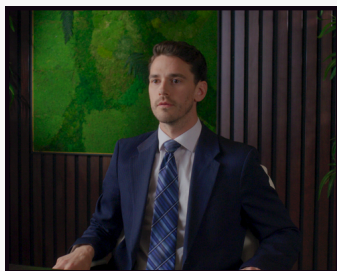

// Director Statement //

***“A sex-positive story about friendship, ambition, and chosen family.”***

*Size Queen* began as a way to explore the lives of queer friends navigating intimacy, ambition, identity, and connection in contemporary Los Angeles. At the center is Chris, a creative standing at a crossroads between the safety of a conventional corporate path and the uncertainty of pursuing something meaningful on his own terms. While the short film captures a pivotal moment in Chris’ life, it also introduces the larger world surrounding him: four friends with very different perspectives on love, sex, relationships, and success. The podcast introduced at the end isn’t the conclusion of the story, it’s the beginning of it. It becomes the space where their conversations unfold with humor, vulnerability, contradiction, and emotional honesty.

As a queer filmmaker, I’m interested in stories that feel grounded, messy, funny, aspirational, and human. *Size Queen* reflects the kinds of friendships and conversations I know intimately: the late-night debates, the emotional spirals, the performative confidence, the search for purpose, and the chosen family we build while figuring ourselves out. The film was also deeply personal for me creatively. After years working in corporate spaces, I decided to take the leap toward filmmaking full-time and finally create the kinds of stories I always wanted to see growing up. In many ways, Chris’ journey mirrors that transition: choosing uncertainty in pursuit of something more authentic.

Los Angeles itself plays an important role in the world of *Size Queen*. I wanted the city to feel alive, stylish, intimate, and cinematic – reflecting the energy of ensemble dramedies that inspired me growing up through HBO and Netflix storytelling.

The short film stands on its own while serving as a glimpse into the larger series centered around friendship, perspective, sex positivity, and the emotional messiness of becoming who you are.

Before transitioning into filmmaking full-time, Kenny worked alongside global brands including Apple and Google after earning a degree in Business Administration with a specialization in Marketing from Stony Brook University. His creative background also includes acting studies at Baron Brown Studio and writing development through Writing Pad.

Size Queen, adapted from his original television pilot, marks Kenny’s directorial debut. Self-produced and filmed in Los Angeles, the project reflects his desire to tell authentic queer stories that feel stylish, funny, emotionally honest, and universally relatable. Kenny was also intentional about casting queer actors in queer roles, prioritizing authenticity, lived experience, and emotional specificity throughout the ensemble.

Kenny hopes to create work that not only entertains audiences, but also encourages other creatives to pursue the stories they feel compelled to tell.
